<i>Persons could be injured if the operator performs duties that are not his responsibility and beyond the scope of his technical capabilities.</i>	Yes	<i>The operator should be adequately trained or licensed. The operator must not carry out any work that is outside his normal duties and report any matters of concern to his supervisor.</i>	Yes
<i>Persons could be injured or experience ill health from exposure to dust.</i>	Yes	<i>An approved dust mask or respirator must be worn. Vacuuming of asbestos, lead based paint dust or other hazardous materials is not allowed.</i>	Yes
<i>Persons could be injured if they slip, trip or fall whilst using the equipment</i>	Yes	<i>Be aware of slippery or wet surfaces. Extend any electrical leads fully before beginning</i>	Yes
<i>Persons could be injured by electrocution</i>	Yes	<i>Use a power supply protected by a safety switch. Do not use in wet or damp conditions. Do not use with faulty leads or plugs. Ensure equipment is tested/tagged for compliance with electrical safety testing requirements.</i>	Yes
<i>Persons could be injured if the machine operator is unfamiliar with typical unsafe conditions and hazards that could affect the safe operation of the unit.</i>	Yes	<i>The operator should be trained in determining unsafe conditions and hazards that are relative to the machine's safe operation.</i>	Yes
<i>Persons could be injured if personal protective equipment is not available or being used when working in an unsatisfactory environment e.g. noise, heat, fumes, etc.</i>	Yes	<i>Instruct the operator to ensure that appropriate personal protective equipment is available and is in good condition prior to commencing work.</i>	Yes
