Before Starting

- 1. Read and understand the Hazard Assessment sheet.
- 2. Do not use extension leads longer than 20 metres.

Setup - Electric Models

- 1. Lay the mixer on the ground, so that the mixer is resting on its wheels and the handles.
- 2. Connect the legs together using the drop bar and pin provided.
- 3. Place the legs inside the bottom of the machine, whilst the machine is laying down.
- 4. Rotate the machine upwards by lifting it from the handles.

To Start the Engine - Petrol models.

- 1. Move ignition switch to the 'on' position.
- 2. Set the throttle to the half throttle position.
- 3. If the engine is cold, turn the choke lever to the 'on' position.
- 4. Turn the fuel tap on.
- 5. Crank the pull cord, until the engine starts.
- 6. Once the engine is running turn the choke off.

Packup

1. Each time machine is stopped, clean mixer by placing a couple of half bricks into mixer with water, and run for 5 mins. Empty contents out.
