DRY VACUUMS

- 1. Ensure the vacuum has the filter inside it.
- 2. Use the correct vacuum for the material that is to be used. E.g for fine dusts, use a fine filter vacuum.

WET VACUUMS

- 1. Ensure the vacuum is capable of being used as a wet vac. The vacuum will be marked accordingly. If unsure consult with your local Glen Iris Hire office.
- 2. If the vacuum is suitable, the filter must be removed when using wet.
- 3. Fine filter vacuums are not suitable for using when wet.
