Persons could be injured if trestle becomes unstable due to planks being used to high.	YES	Do not use planks over 2 metres above the ground. Use only on level and firm ground.	YES
Persons could be injured if the operator is unfamiliar with typical unsafe conditions and hazards that could affect the safe operation of the unit.	YES	The operator should be trained in determining unsafe conditions and hazards that are relative to the machine's safe operation.	YES
Persons could be injured if the operator performs duties that are not his responsibility and beyond the scope of his technical capabilities.	YES	The operator should be instructed not to carry out any work that is outside his normal duties and report any matters of concern to his supervisors.	YES
