Persons could be injured if the operator performs duties that are not his responsibility and beyond the scope of his technical capabilities.	YES	The operator should be adequately trained or licensed. The operator must not carry out any work that is outside his normal duties and report any matters of concern to his supervisor.	YES
Persons could be injured as a result of electrocution.	YES	Ensure lead is well clear of heat source. Use a power supply protected by a safety switch. Do not use in wet or damp conditions. Do not use with faulty leads or plugs. Ensure equipment is tested/tagged for compliance with electrical safety testing requirements.	YES
Persons could be injured if they slip, trip or fall around the light.	YES	Ensure the light is placed in a position where it will be least likely to be tripped over or bumped. Keep all leads untangled and clear of thoroughfares.	YES
Persons could be injured if light strip overheats and melts	YES	Light strip should always be fully uncoiled from drum while in use to prevent overheating	YES
